### Awards for Individual Project Management Achievement

#### Young Project Manager of the Year



The category is open specifically to project practitioners with demonstrated professional skills, and is within the age bracket of 18 -35 and who has / is working on any type of project anywhere in the world.

#### Project Manager of the Year



The category is open to Project Manager with the demonstrated professional skills equivalent to IPMA Four-Level Certification

other recognised comparable Project ОГ Management Certification from an IPMA Member Association) with no age distinction.

### Awards for the Management of Projects


#### Internationally Funded Humanitarian Aid Project Community Service/Development Project



Projects that demonstrate project management excellence achievement / in deliverina Humanitarian Aid Projects which have an international funding source, such as Postdisaster recovery projects and refugee projects. Awards to this category may result from submissions received or from specific peer nominations.



This category recognizes where project management has made a major contribution to a local project of benefit to the community or the environment. Community, cultural or volunteer-based projects development, underpin/promote the education. preservation and well being of indigenous, disadvantaged, or disabled people or which are undertaken in not-for-profit organisations.



**Requirements:** The IPMA Young Project Manager of the Year is open to project managers aged between 18 to 35 at the time of applying; project professionals who have worked or are currently working on a project for at least six months. The criteria for evaluation of the award is based upon the ICB (IPMA Competence Baseline), and finalists will be chosen based upon the strength of their overall competence development. The project(s) undertaken may be of any size or value, from either the public or private sector and can be located anywhere in the world.
